And we will invest in places of possibility, first-rate facilities where our faculty and students live, work, and learn.

As we step into 2024, we are also entering a new era of illumination at Berkeley. Thank you for lighting the way.

## Financial Remarks

At year-end 2023, Prytanean Alumnae had total investment funds of \$1,787,802, a 19% increase from year-end 2022. Our largest investment portfolio, which is exclusively earmarked for the Prytanean Faculty Enrichment Award, grew to \$1,155,338. This portfolio is managed by Fisher Investments, with whom we have worked closely on long-term planning. Following in-depth discussions and cash flow analyses, we increased the amount of the Faculty Enrichment Award from \$25,000 to \$35,000 in 2023.

Prytanean’s remaining investment funds of \$632,464 are managed as endowments by either UC Berkeley Foundation or UC Regents. These funds are dedicated to the Faculty Enrichment Award as well as various student scholarships: the Mary Wiley Stecker and Prytanean Women Awards in the College of Letters and Science, Engineering, Math and Science, and Architecture and Technology, and the Rowena Hamilton Memorial Scholarship. We are pleased to confirm that our investment funds are sufficient to continue awarding our annual \$35,000 Faculty Enrichment Award and student scholarships for the foreseeable future.

We had operating funds of approximately \$50,000 at the end of 2023. Membership dues and donations generally make up our operating revenue and support our operating expenses, including the costs of our annual newsletter, the Faculty Award Reception, the Annual Brunch, the Prytanean Retreat, database maintenance, plus the collegiates’ Prytanean Honor Society operating budget, Campus Projects, and graduation stoles.

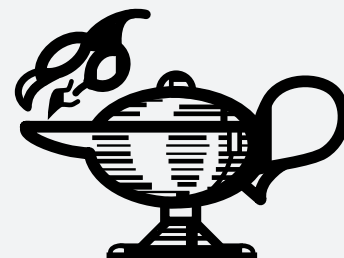

## Alum in the Spotlight

**Linda Jo Fitz '66**—Last Fall the Bay Area historical preservation community filled two levels of the San Francisco City Club at a Grand Gala to honor Linda Jo Fitz. Linda has been on the Board of Directors of the San Francisco Architectural Heritage for close to twenty years. That Heritage group works to preserve historic buildings and art in San Francisco, and recognized Linda's "lifetime contribution" toward that pursuit. Linda also has been a leader in the San Francisco Bay Area Planning and Urban Research Association (SPUR) and in the American Conservatory Theater (A.C.T.). A philanthropist and certified planner, she co-started a successful wealth management firm, now called "Aspiriant." San Francisco Business Times named her as one of "The Most Influential Businesswomen" and Wealth Manager Magazine named her as "One of the Top 50 Women in Business." For years Linda gave sound investment guidance to Prytanean Alumnae, Inc. on a pro-bono basis, and generously answered financial questions at our annual Spring brunch.

## Remarkable Prytaneans

**Ruth Sherman Tolman (1893 – 1957)** is a real-life character in last year's blockbuster film, *Oppenheimer*. As a very close friend of Robert Oppenheimer, she was inexorably connected to the story of the covert formulation of the atom bomb. But Ruth Tolman was much more than an intimate of the man who developed the destructive and lethal bomb. She devoted herself to establishing the discipline of clinical psychology, and pioneered treatment methods for WWII veterans with PTSD. She trained psychologists and created occupational tests including mental stability test for agents of the Office of Strategic Services (now called "the CIA"). Her articles on "mental hygiene" appear in influential journals. A recipient of a PhD from Cal in 1937, Ruth Tolman was a Professor at UCLA, a President of the Western Psychological Association, a Fellow of the American Psychological Association, and a Member of the Council of the Society of the Psychological Study of Social Issues. For most of her adult life, she lived on the campus of the California Institute of Technology in Pasadena.

This year's Rowena Hamilton Award recipient was Kennedy Goss, a senior who is an attacker on the Women's Lacrosse Team. Kennedy holds the Cal record for most number of draw controls (202). In her spare time, she volunteers her time as a graphic designer for Project 31, a non-profit organization that mentors, leads and inspires young women to live lives worth following by creating leadership opportunities, building self-confidence, and serving others.

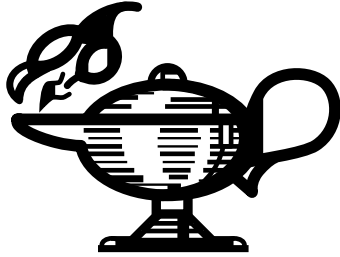
